- 2. to express properly some basic information and immediate needs in spoken and written modern Korean
- 3. to respond to simple, direct questions or requests for information in spoken and written modern Korean
- 4. to understand Korean language in cultural context

#### **VI. Course Requirements:**

- **1. Attendance**: First **FOUR** absences will be excused; each unjustified absence thereafter will reduce your grade by 1% (out of 100%). Each late arrival (after 5 minutes) will reduce your grade by 0.5%. Absence due to medical emergency can be excused with an official proof such as doctor's notes, etc. *Only absences or late arrivals with Official Proofs will be excused.*
- **2. Homework** will be given eight times mostly weekly base. Each homework will be posted by Wednesday night on the Blackboard and it is due on the next Monday (TA class). If you cannot come to Monday class, you can either submit it via e-mail to the instructor/TA or leave it in the drop box on the door of the instructor's/TA's office. Homework will be checked and returned to you on the next Thursday class. It will be graded on the completion base. Late homework will be accepted by two weeks later than the due date and will get only 50% of its full credit. If anybody has any technical problems to download and print out homework from the Blackboard, ask for a hard copy to the instructor or the TA.
- **3. Dictation exams** will be given eight times in Thursday classes. Each covers the main text contents lectured in the previous classes. You can drop the lowest score, but there will be NO make-ups.
- **4. Quizzes** will be given eight times in Tuesday classes. Each quiz will mainly test the basic vocabulary of the text covered in the previous classes. You can drop the lowest score, but there will be NO make-ups.

#### 5. Exams

- (a) **Midterm Exams** will be given in the  $9^{th}$  week; the Oral Midterm exam will be an interview with the instructor, covering 10 % of the final grade, and the Written Midterm exam will cover 10 % of the final grade.
- **(b) Final Exams** will compose of an Oral Final Presentation and a Written Final Exam. The Oral Final exam is a skit presentation which will be given on the last class day, covering 10% of the final grade. The Written Final Exam will be given at the designated time and location scheduled by the University during the official final exam period, covering 15% of the final grade. **The exam date and location: TBA**
- **6. Mini-CULTURA project**: Every two other weeks, you are supposed to respond to my questions at Facebook(Guidelines will be provided.). You must leave your response by SUNDAY 11pm in your NATIVE LANGUAGE. You are also supposed to read at least two other answers and leave a short analysis or comment by WEDSESDAY 11pm (in your native language). No late postings are allowed, so please keep the timeline.
- **7. TA's Sessions**: The TA, Juwon Lee, will be teaching on Mondays. He will focus on practices and other important usages with exercise sections of the textbook.
