Your application must include all of the following items and be submitted in both hard copy and electronic forms:

- 1) A completed copy of the application.
- 2) An up to date CV. This document should include all experience related to study abroad, leadership, and extra-curriculars as well as research.
- 3) A one-page, single spaced description of your proposed research project that explains both significance and methodology. Please describe both your motivations and qualifications for the proposed project.
- 4) A letter of recommendation from the UT Faculty member who will supervise your project. The letter should be sent directly to the Director, Dr. Elizabeth Scala, scala@austin.utexas.edu. Emailed letters are fine. There is no need to acquire a hard copy of this part of the application.
