Steps for the year you're applying

1. Decide on **types of programs** you want to apply to
2. Make your list of **specific schools and advisors**
3. Prepare for and take general **GRE**
4. Prepare for and take **Psychology GRE**
5. Develop an **organizational system**
6. Possibly **contact** potential advisors
7. Ask people to write your **letters of recommendation**
8. Order your **transcripts**
9. Write your **personal statement**
10. Optional: Prepare a **CV**
11. Finalize materials; **submit all materials**
12. Go to **interviews**
13. Make your **decision!**
