General Eligibility:

Any student enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate program at UT who intends to travel to Israel or to American institutions to conduct research or pursue Hebrew study.

Purpose:

To help support travel abroad for Hebrew language programs or for research in Israel or at archives, museums, or institutes abroad or in the US that hold materials relevant to Israel Studies scholarship.

Amount: Reimbursement up to \$2,000.
