

Intern / Volunteer Application

The Texas Archeological Research Lab (TARL) offers unpaid internships and volunteer opportunities for students and community volunteers. TARL hours are 8 AM-5 PM Monday through Friday. Volunteers are used in areas of greatest need and best fit to their skills and ability to learn new tasks. Volunteers are scheduled around the students receiving credit for their work. There is very limited lab space and so limitations will apply. Due to the high demand for intern slots, a waiting list is a common occurrence.

- Potential interns are asked to submit applications at least one semester ahead of the desired term.
- Volunteers are taken when schedules can be accommodated.
- Priority is given to UT students, anthropology students and to graduating seniors using a straight first come-first serve policy.

Although, no experience is required, the ability to work at least 3-4 hours at a time, sometimes doing repetitive work and the ability to lift up to 30 pounds, is necessary.
